



Ninja Hunt competition

OVERVIEW (NOT PART OF THE CONDITIONS)

HOW TO ENTER

To enter, participants must complete the competition entry form which is provided to ticket holders of the Game On 2.0 exhibition being held at the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery ("QVMAG") at Inveresk in Launceston, Tasmania.

To be eligible, entrants must complete the entry form in full and include the correct number of "MyState Financial Ninjas" token sticker that are located within the Game On 2.0 exhibition. There are six opportunities to win and the competition will be drawn on the draw dates listed below. The winners drawn must have the correct answer listed on their competition entry form.

Winners will be notified by telephone on the day the competition is drawn and their name and town or city of residence will be announced on the website mystate.com.au.

CONDITIONS – PARTICIPATION

2. Entry to the Competition constitutes acceptance of these conditions. All entry instructions and prize information published by the Promoter form part of these conditions.
3. The Competition is only open to Eligible Entrants. An "Eligible Entrant" is an individual who: (i) participates by entering a name on the competition form, which is available from the ticket booth at the Game On 2.0 exhibition being held at the QVMAG in Launceston; (ii) has parental permission to enter the competition; (iii) is not an employee of the Promoter or any of its related corporations or any of their agencies associated with the Competition (or a spouse, defacto spouse, parent, child or sibling (whether natural or by adoption) of such an employee); and (iv) is not an employee or volunteer of the QVMAG.
4. Competition entry opens at 6:00pm on Friday 2nd July 2010 and closes at 6:00pm on Sunday 3rd October 2010 ("Entry Period").

ENTRY GENERAL

5. For a chance to win, Eligible Entrants must complete the entry form in full and state the correct number of "MyState Financial Ninjas" token sticker that are located within the Game On 2.0 exhibition. The MyState Financial "Ninjas" are only located inside the exhibition and are attached with adhesive material
6. Entrants must be a valid ticket holder to the Game On 2.0 exhibition being held at the QVMAG in Launceston, Tasmania between Friday 2nd July 2010 and Sunday 3rd October 2010. Entry forms are distributed by the ticket seller outside the exhibition entrance.
7. Subject to the other conditions, an Eligible Entrant may enter the Competition once for every entry to the exhibition during the Entry Period.
8. All entries to the Competition may be subject to verification by the Promoter.
9. The Promoter may, at its absolute discretion, declare any or all entries made by an entrant invalid if the entrant: (i) fails to establish their entitlement to enter the Competition to the Promoter's satisfaction; or (ii) fails to produce items as required by condition 8) or produces items that, in the Promoter's opinion, are illegible, stolen, forged, reconstructed, altered, incomplete or tampered with in any way; or (iii) in the Promoter's opinion, tampers with the entry process or benefits from such tampering; or (iv) in the Promoter's opinion, submits an entry which is not in accordance with these conditions.
10. An entry by more than one person (ie a joint entry) is invalid.

PRIZES

UNCLAIMED PRIZES

20. The names of prize winners who have won prizes will be published on the "Promoters" website mystate.com.au on the day of the prize draw.

GENERAL

21. If for any reason the conduct or operation of the Competition is interfered with or disrupted in any way (including by vandalism, power failures, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes, computer bugs or viruses, tampering or technical failures), the Promoter reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend or recommence the Competition, subject to the approval of the authorities that have issued permits for its conduct.
22. All of the Promoter's decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
23. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax liability incurred as a result of an entrant participating in the Competition. Entrants should obtain independent tax and financial advice.

To the full extent permitted by law, the Promoter, its associated companies and agencies and all those entities' personnel (the "Relevant Parties") exclude all liability for any loss (including any damage, claim, injury, cost or expense) which is suffered or incurred by any Eligible Entrant through use of the products purchased with the prize voucher, including: (i) any indirect, economic or consequential loss; (ii) any loss arising from the negligence of a Relevant Party; (iii) any liability for personal injury or death.
